Explanation of Benefits and Payment.

The following is a breakdown of the services, costs and benefits you can expect to receive during the year leading up to your B'nai Mitzvah, including the day of the service. The total cost of these benefits is \$6,500 and includes the following:

Ongoing Education:

^{*}Venue rental is not included in Open Temple's services. Families are responsible for booking and payment of all venues, including Electric Lodge. If you'd like to use Electric Lodge you must book with them directly.

Open Temple allows for families to pay the total amount upfront or over time with a set payment plan. If you would like to register for a payment plan, our standard formula is explained below. Full payment is due 6 weeks before the date of the B'nai Mitzvah.

\$6,500 / # of months until due

For example, if the B'nai Mitzvah is scheduled to take place on June 1, full payment must be received by April 20. To set up a payment plan that starts June of the previous year your payment will take place over 10 months, resulting in a monthly payment of \$650. If you would like to move forward with the payment plan, we require a payment authorization form allowing us to automatically set up payments each month. You are welcome to authorize payment from a bank account or credit card.

Please note that in order to participate in our B'nai Mitzvah program, you must have a Family Co-Creator membership with Open Temple. This membership is a separate cost, and comes with additional benefits. For more information on how to become a Co-Creator please contact Open Temple.
